## Calf Scramble SPECIAL RULES

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1. All entries in this department are subject to the General Rules of the Youth Expo of Harris County and the Special Rules of the Junior Livestock Show.

2. Calf Scramble participants will be limited to FFA and 4-H Club members residing within or attending school within Harris County.

3. Applicants must have reached their 13<sup>th</sup>, but not their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday on Jan.1, 2010 and not be enrolled beyond their junior year in high school.

4. Applicants must be able to provide suitable facilities for caring and developing an animal project.

5. Applicants must be able to run and perform procedures necessary to scramble.

6. Participants appearing with broken limbs or evidence of a recent injury will automatically be disqualified and replaced by the first eligible alternate.

7. The Youth Expo will randomly select forty (40) applicants to participate in the Calf Scramble, to be held Friday, October 29th at 6:30 pm.

8. The Youth Expo will award twenty (20) \$500 certificates to be used towards any market or breeding animal project to be exhibited at the 2010 Youth Expo of Harris County.

9. Seventy Percent (\$350.00) of funding will occur upon inception of the animal project. Exhibitors must provide proof of purchase price in order to receive funding. The remaining balance (\$150.00) will be provided at the 2011 Youth Expo.

10. In the event that the purchase price of the animal project does not exceed \$500, exhibitors must provide proof of feed and care expenses in order receive the remaining balance of their certificate.

11. Participants who have already received a Youth Expo Calf Scramble Certificate are ineligible.

Applications must be filled out entirely and signed by exhibitor, parent and advisor. No partial applications will be accepted. Applications must be mailed on or before October 1<sup>st</sup> to:

## RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, for being allowed entry into and participation in activities (the "Activities") associated with the Youth Expo of Harris County., (collectively, "YEHC"), the undersigned hereby enters into this RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT (this "Agreement") as of the date set forth below.

1. <u>ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS</u>: The undersigned recognizes and understands that there are risks associated with their participation in the Activities including, but not limited to, bodily injury or death to persons and damage to property. The undersigned further acknowledges and understands that they will be held liable and responsible for any and all damage to persons, livestock, vehicles, property and/or improvements to property that is caused by them and/or any persons (including, but not limited to, minors) under their care and control, and that arise out of, or are related to, the undersigned's entry into and participation in the Activities.

2. <u>APPLICABILITY AND SCOPE OF RELEASES AND INDEMNITIES:</u> For purposes of this Agreement, "Claims" shall mean any past, present and future claims, losses, costs, expenses, liabilities, demands, or causes of action, and costs of defense or settlement (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees and court costs). The releases, waivers and indemnities contained in this Agreement expressly shall apply regardless of whether the Claims to be released, waived or indemnified against arise, or are alleged to arise, from (i) **NEGLIGENCE (WHETHER SOLE, JOINT OR CONCURRENT), GROSS NEGLIGENCE, NEGLIGENCE PER SE, and/or STRICT LIABILITY**, of YEHC or their respective present and former officers, directors, members, subsidiaries, affiliates, employees, staff and agents and any other person, firm or corporation bound to defend or pay judgments against them (the "Released Parties"); (ii) personal injury, death or property damage; (iii) acts under the Texas Deceptive Trade Practices Act ("DTPA"); (iv) acts of any other persons or guests; (v) theft, burglary, assault, or other crimes; (vi) fire, water, wind, rain and/or smoke and/or (vii) any other risks and hazards associated with the undersigned's entry into and participation in the Activities, including, but not limited to, the general conditions at the Activities, animals both wild and domestic that may be diseased and/or potentially dangerous, persons with firearms both on and off the premises used in connection with the Activities, and the driving or riding in any vehicles, whether belonging to Released Parties or to other persons.

3. <u>RELEASE FROM LIABILITY:</u> The undersigned hereby RELEASES, ACQUITS AND FOREVER DISCHARGES, and WAIVES any and all Claims against any of the Released Parties that arise from or relate to their entry and participation in the Activities—including, but not limited to, the types of claims enumerated in Paragraph 2—and agree not to sue any of the Released Parties for such Claims. Without limiting the foregoing, the undersigned agrees that the Released Parties shall not be liable to them, their family, or their guests, for personal injury, property damage, or any other Claims arising from or related to the undersigned's entry into and participation in the Activities.

4. <u>AGREEMENT TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS:</u> The undersigned agrees to INDEMNIFY and HOLD HARMLESS the Released Parties against any and all Claims arising from or related to the undersigned's entry and participation in the Activities—including, but not limited to, the types of Claims enumerated in Paragraph 2. In addition, and without limiting the foregoing, the undersigned agrees to INDEMNIFY the Released Parties for any Claims for injuries to any minors under their care and control and/or his or her parent/guardian, and for any Claims asserted by, through or under the undersigned, arising from or related to the undersigned's entry into and participation in the Activities—including, but not limited to, the types of Claims enumerated in Paragraph 2. As used herein, "INDEMNIFY" means to agree to assume the Released Parties' liability in a situation, thereby relieving them of responsibility, and/or reimbursing the Released Party for Claims asserted against them.

5. <u>PHOTOGRAPH/INTERVIEW RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT</u>: The undersigned GRANTS PERMISSION to be PHOTOGRAPHED or INTERVIEWED in connection with the Activities. The undersigned understands that any such photograph or interview may be used by the Released Parties or television, film, video, visual, graphic or printed media. The undersigned agrees to RELEASE and INDEMNIFY the Released Parties with respect to any Claims related to the usage of such photographs or interviews by the Released Parties or any media —including, but not limited to, the types of Claims enumerated in Paragraph 2.

As further inducement to YEHC to permit the undersigned's entry into and participation in the Activities, the undersigned represents that they thoroughly and completely understand that this is a complete and final release and indemnity agreement, that they are freely and voluntarily entering into this Agreement, and that no representations, promises or statements made by any Released Party, or any agent, attorney or other representative of any Released Party has influenced the undersigned in causing them to sign this Agreement.

The undersigned understands that this agreement shall be binding on their heirs, executors, successors and assigns, that the Agreement will be governed by the laws of Texas, and that jurisdiction and venue for resolution of any dispute regarding this Agreement shall lie in a Texas State Court in Harris County, Texas. If any part of this Agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, it does not affect the validity of the remainder of this Agreement. The undersigned agrees to the terms and conditions above, and acknowledges receipt of this Agreement.
